Chinese Fun Writing Workshop 有趣揮春工作坊

Fai Chun, also known as spring festival couplets, is a traditional decoration used to celebrate Chinese New Year and the onset of spring. Auspicious words are written on red paper in beautiful calligraphy. They are usually pasted on the wall or door during Chinese New Year to light up the festive atmosphere. In addition, spring couplets originated from Taofu, and are believed to bring fortune and ward off evil spirits.

In this fun workshop, the instructor will introduce the traditions behind Fai Chun while junior Members can write down their favourite words to express their auspicious new year wishes.
